DESCRIPTION

TOILET, URINAL AND WASHROOM DISINFECTANT

BLUE THUNDER is a versatile hospital grade washroom cleaner and disinfectant with extra cleaning power to remove heavy soiling and scale deposits. Formulated to remove body fats and soap scale and will neutralise mildew and algae growths. **BLUE THUNDER** is safe for stainless steel, porcelain urinals, toilet bowls, basins and concrete tiled washroom areas.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

TOILET BOWL AND URINAL CLEANER:

Squirt or pour **BLUE THUNDER** directly on all surfaces to be cleaned. Brush difficult stains and leave as long as possible. Flush with water to finish.

DISINFECTANT / CLEANER APPLICATION:

Dilute 50mls / litre water

FLOORS:

Dilute solution in hot water and mop over area with mop.

WALLS, TOILETS, BENCH TOPS, BASINS ETC:

Dilute solution in hot water to comfort and apply with a damp sponge or cloth.

NB: Do not mix with detergents or other chemicals

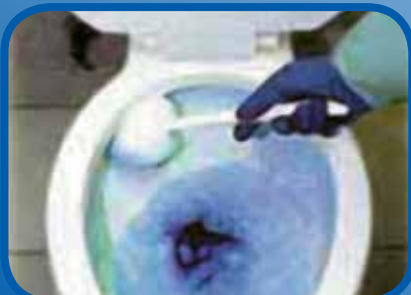

FIRST AID

IF SWALLOWED: Immediately call a POISON CENTER or doctor/physician. IF SWALLOWED: Rinse mouth. Do NOT induce vomiting. IF ON SKIN (or hair): Remove/ Take off immediately all contaminated clothing. Rinse skin with water/shower. IF INHALED: Remove victim to fresh air and keep at rest in a position comfortable for breathing. IF IN EYES: Rinse cautiously with water for several minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present and easy to do. Continue rinsing. Immediately call a POISON CENTER or doctor/physician. Rinse mouth. Wash contaminated clothing before use.
