Carpet Spotter, Soil Break & Extraction Concentrate

CARPET X is a biodegradable all in one carpet extraction cleaning concentrate that can be used in all phases of carpet cleaning. **CARPET X** provides high performance results as an extraction cleaner, carpet bonnet buffer and high traffic cleaner & pre-spray. **CARPET X** is a three way cleaner formulated with grease cutters, soils suspending agents, anti-static agents and powerful penetrating solvents. **CARPET X** is an exceptionally versatile product with a wide variety of usage in the cleaning industry.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

SPOTTING

Dilute 1 part to 5 parts warm water and apply with trigger spray. Agitate and sponge or extract.

PRE-SPRAY

Dilute 1 part to 10 to 15 parts water depending on soilage. Apply with pump or trigger spray then extract.

BONNET / PADS

Dilute 1 part to 20 parts water. Dip bonnet in solution and buff 2 meter square area in soilage lanes.

EXTRACTION MACHINES

Heavy Soilage: Dilute 1 part to 100 parts water in solution tank. (200 ml to 20 Ltrs or approx 1 cup).

Medium Soilage: Dilute 1 part to 175 parts water in solution tank. (120 ml to 20 Ltrs or approx 2/3 cup).

Light Soilage: Dilute 1 part to 300 parts water in solution tank. (50 ml to 20 Ltrs or approx 1/3 cup).

NB: For best performance hot water should be used. Wool carpet should be no hotter than 70°, Synthetics 80°.

FIRST AID
