Automatic Machine Dishwashing Detergent

DISHBRITE is a highly active alkaline machine dishwashing formulation. Contains sanitisers, grease cutters and sequesterants to remove grease stains and hard water film ensuring sparkling clean and germ free dishes. Also contains low foam wetting agents to ensure quick drying and efficient machine operation. This product is also suitable to use for machine pot washers commonly found in food processing plants.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Specifically for machine dish washing applications

Automatic Dispensing: Place the drum under the bench with the suction tube positioned to the bottom of the container. The dispenser will automatically dispense the product.

FIRST AID
